July 21, 2026

I Meeting called to order

The Scott Township Board of Supervisors' monthly business meeting was called to order on July 21, 2026 at 7:20 p.m. at the Joe Terry Civic Center, 1038 Montdale Road, Scott Township, PA 18447. The meeting was opened by Supervisor Giannetta with the Pledge of Allegiance. In attendance were Supervisor Giannetta, Supervisor Brenzel, Attorney Fanucci, Township Administrator Carl Ferraro, and Secretary/Treasurer Diana Campbell.

II Zoning

Mr. Ferraro stated that the Community Reinvest Funds were awarded to help offset the cost of the AEDs.

III Public Comment on Agenda Items

Rose Knick questioned the Zoning Hearing Board hearings, the Supervisor appointment and asked to comment next month on the bills once she has a chance to review them. Karen Cecchini questioned why the vacancy board has not yet convened. Attorney Fanucci explained that the Supervisors have 30 days from the day they accepted the resignation. If the two Supervisors cannot agree, then the vacancy board is convened and they have 15 days to make an appointment. Joe Wasko asked regarding the referendum for EMS tax, how it came about, how many hours it would add and how much tax money it would produce. Supervisor Giannetta explained that he would like to add a second shift, provided by Scott Hose, to have EMT coverage from 6 am to midnight. He has spoken to representatives from both Justus and Scott and both are agreeable, but it is ultimately up to the voters. Karen Cecchini questioned the bills.

IV Supervisor Appointment

Supervisor Giannetta announced the applicants and allowed anyone who did not address the public to do so. Mr. Robert O'Leary and Mr. Kevin Sullivan introduced themselves.

A motion was made by Supervisor Giannetta to appoint Kevin Sullivan as Scott Township Supervisor to fill the unexpired term through December, 2027. There was no second. Motion died.

A motion was made by Supervisor Brenzel to appoint Robert O'Leary as Scott Township Supervisor to fill the unexpired term through December, 2027. There was no second. Motion died.

Supervisor Giannetta made a motion to amend the agenda to add motion #7, advertising a special meeting to convene the vacancy board on Tuesday, July 28, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. Seconded by Supervisor Brenzel. Motion carried.

**SCOTT TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
MARCH 4, 2026**

The Meeting was called to order at 7:08 PM on Wednesday, March 4, 2026. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and attendance was taken. Present: William Kaiser, Sal Maiolatesi, Walter Peregrim, Scott Suda, Brian Grippi, Bill Novak, and Pat Kasper. Also present was Carl Ferraro, Code Enforcement Officer.

The minutes from February 3, 2026, were reviewed. A motion to accept the minutes as presented was made by Mr. Maiolatesi and seconded by Mr. Suda. All in favor.

Supervisor Michael Giannetta gave a brief summary of the evolution of the Scott Township Zoning Ordinance that would provide definitions and regulations for solar farms and data centers.

The Board then proceeded to review and discuss Draft Copy 3 of the proposed Zoning Ordinance.

Mr. Peregrim asked the Board to bear in mind there are residents would may desire to sell their property for the development of solar farms.

Page 3 Solar Farm: Mr. Kaiser questioned the vagueness of the word “large” and therefore would like to see it defined by the amount of acreage.

Mr. Suda expressed concern about the longevity of solar farms and their solar panels.

Page 4 Solar Farms 1.) -4.) Mr. Suda pointed out there is no mention of the issue of glare and the decommissioning is vague.

Mr. Grippi responded that the solar material can be sold and the site restored to pre-development condition. He then introduced Ordinance

No. 49, 2024, 612:12 from Erie County pertaining to Decommissioning as an example, especially focusing on the following:

#3. To the extent possible, the materials shall be re-sold or salvaged. Materials that cannot be re-sold or salvaged shall be disposed of at a facility authorized to dispose of such materials by federal or state law.

#4 Any soil exposed during the removal shall be stabilized in accordance with applicable erosion and sediment control standards.

#6 The SEF site area shall be restored to its pre-development condition, suitable for its prior use Except in the case that the landowner authorizes in writing any buffer landscaping or access roads installed to remain.

#9 The facility owner shall, at the time of the land development plan application, provide the municipality with an estimate of the cost of performing the decommissioning activities required herein. The facility owner shall provide financial security of 110% of the estimated cost of decommissioning. The estimate may include an estimated salvage and resale value, discounted by a factor of 10%. The decommissioning cost estimate formula shall be: gross cost of decommissioning activities minus 90% credit of salvage and resale value equals the decommissioning cost estimate.

#10 On every 5th anniversary of the date of providing the decommissioning financial security, the facility owner shall provide an updated decommission cost estimate, utilizing the formula set forth above with adjustments for inflation and cost and value changes. If the decommissioning security amount increases, the facility owner shall remit the increased financial security to the municipality within 30 days of the approval of the updated decommissioning security estimate by the municipality. If the decommissioning security amount decreases by greater than 10%, the municipality shall release from security any amount held in excess of 110% of the updated decommission cost estimate.

#11 Decommissioning security estimates shall be subject to review and approval by the municipality, and the facility owner shall be responsible for administrative, legal, and engineering costs incurred by the municipality for such review.

Page 5 Mr. Maiolatesi remarked there is conflicting setback information compared to page 10, item #16.

Page 6 Mr. Maiolatesi recommended the section stating "60 acres may be combined in more than one municipality" be deleted.

Mr. Novak pointed out the building, powerlines and water tower heights and recommended 100 feet for powerlines and 70 feet for the water tower.

Page 7 Mr. Maiolatesi compared to **page 15** for clarification. It was decided to change Nuclear to Radiological and **verify** that "The Radiological Land Survey must show measurements at external perimeter points of the property which must include measurements taken at perimeter points within 400 feet of residential or commercial activity." (See section a.)

Page 8 Mr. Kaiser and Mr. Maiolatesi presented for discussion the closed loop for water use.

Page 10 #14 and #16 Two more conflicting measurements in items #14 and #16 when compared to page 5. #14 should be changed to a minimum of 100 feet and #16 should be 400 feet.

Page 11 #18 Decommissioning: use Mr. Grippi's recommendation.

C. 2 Woodland standards: Mr. Maiolatesi pointed out the woodland standard buffer of at least 100 feet be maintained. Mr. Novak stated the trees planted should match the Township Ordinance of growth to 15 feet in 3 years.

C. 3 Mr. Kaiser talked of the importance of adequate ingress and egress.

Page 12 E. Water Service Mr. Novak put forth a requirement that well water shall be for domestic needs and fire suppression only. And DCE cooling will be closed-loop. This should be inserted between items 1 and 2.

#2 the water feasibility study should be expanded from 1000 feet to 1500 feet of all external property lines. Also, there should be a study of the wells, a baseline analysis, before the water study. Mr. Suda suggested that there be a continuous study during the years a data center is in use.

#2c the location of all existing and proposed wells should be within 1500 feet of the site.

Page 13 F. Electric Use 1. In the third line the word should be **maintaining** instead of "maintain." Discussion ensued regarding the electric use. It should not be the rate payers' responsibility.

Pages 13 and 14 Noise Control Mr. Novak recommended an outside sound study. Mr. Suda stressed the sound study should be done on a regular basis and the company should be held accountable. Mr. Suda questioned if a fine can be assessed and inserted in this section.

In paragraph c.) change 65Db and 55Db to 65dB and 55dB.

Page 16 Data Center Procedures A. "Upon submission of the Master Plan, change **each** Township to **the** Township." In the fourth line "dialogue with the applicant and advise" change **him/her** to **them**.
Paragraph B second line change **Municipality** to **Township**.

Page 17 #6 change impervious to pervious.

Final thoughts/comments: Mr. Suda asked if emergency services were sufficiently covered and what arrangements or requirements were for disposal of equipment such as computers and general waste.

Public Comment: Ms. Knick chose to wait until Ordinance is on the record.

Mrs. Suda asked about the amount of land in the Industrial District and what material will be in the warehouse.

Mr. Maiolatesi made a motion to continue review of the Ordinance on March 18, at 7:00. Mr. Suda seconded. All in favor, meeting adjourned.

MEETING MINUTES
MARCH 18, 2026

The purpose of this meeting is to continue the review and revision of the proposed Solar Farm and Data Center Ordinance. Present are Bill Kaiser, Sal Maiolatesi, Brian Grippi, Scott Suda, Bill Novak, and Pat Kasper. Also present, Carl Ferraro, Code Enforcement Officer.

The meeting commenced at 7:10 with the following revisions and discussion:

Page 2 under Data Center Accessory Uses- remove typo letter g first line.

Page 3 Mr. Suda asked if consideration should be given to the use of “megawatt.” Also, the type of evergreen used for the buffer can be specified in the conditional use process.

Page 4 number 4 Mr. Suda stated there should be a notification process of 90 days when the panels are decommissioned and should it have a time line.

Page 5 number 1 should include Mr. Suda’s suggestion from page 4.

Page 6 Correction to Minimum Setback: All buildings shall be set at the greater of **400 feet** from any existing primary residential structure on an adjoining lot

Page 10 number 1 line 3 Mr. Kaiser questioned if SMR should be written Small Modular Reactor.

Page 11 number 14 line 3 the word fifty should be removed as the correct number is 100 feet.

Page 12 number 16 change 300 feet to **400 feet**.

Page 13 Water Service (See also Solar and DCE Ordinance text adders as rewritten)

Letter E. number 2 line: 4 Mister Novak initiated discussion of the impact on wells, therefore line four should read **two miles** of all external property lines. Also, on text adders sheet change to **2 miles** in paragraph 3 line 3 and also in 3 (c) “the

location of all existing and proposed wells within **2 miles** of the site, with a notation of the capacity of all high-yield wells.”

Page 14 letter c should read “wells within 2 miles of the site”

Page 14 letter (i) Mr. Kaiser requested this statement should be made letter (i.) *Any well water use shall be for fire suppression and domestic needs only. Well water shall **not** be used for DCE cooling systems.*

Letter (i) is now Data Centers shall used closed loop cooling to minimize water consumption.

Mr. Maiolatesi emphasized the closed loop cooling system. Adiabatic Closed-loop Cooling was discussed as it offers superior cooling performance and is commonly used in data centers.

On text adders sheet: number 4 line 1 change Developer to **Developer/Operator**. Also, **paragraph 2 line 1** the Developer should read the **Developer/Operator**.

Page 16 Mr. Maiolatesi requested paragraph letter **H** topic be changed to **Air Quality Baseline Study**. “This study will be performed by a qualified engineering firm acceptable to the Township. This air quality test will be at the request of the Township by a qualified engineer.”

Change Buffering to Letter I; Change Radiological to Letter J; Change State to Letter K

Page 18 Letter A line 1 change **each** Township to **the Township**

Mr. Kaiser made a motion to forward Version 5 of the Solar and DCE Ordinance to the Supervisors containing the corrections and updates from the Planning Commission meetings of March 3 and March 18 thereby recommending that the Supervisors accept. Mr. Maiolatesi seconded. All in favor.

Mr. Maiolatesi made a motion to adjourn, Mr. Suda seconded it. All in favor. Meeting adjourned at 8:15.
