Dear Scott Township Homeowner,

This letter addresses homeowners who will be on the new central sewer system and those who will still have on-lot systems.

Part one pertains to residents who will be hooked up to the Scott Township sanitary sewer system. Part two pertains to residents who will be covered by the "on-lot Management System".

PART I : Homeowners on the New Central Sewer System:

Hookups to the central sewer system tentatively will begin on June 1st 2011 and must be completed before September 1, 2011. The "hookup" will entail connecting your home's plumbing to a Sewer authority supplied grinder pump, and running a 1.25in line from that pump to the curb stop installed at the edge of your property. The cost of this work is the responsibility of the homeowner. The work also requires a 240 circuit to power the pump as well as pumping and filling your old septic tank with sand or dirt. All of this work must be performed by someone who has attended one of the E-One training classes run by the Scott Township Sewer Authority. The pump and lateral installation requires Uniform Construction Code permits and inspections by the township. The total cost of the permits and inspections for the homeowner will be approximately \$104.00. Any contractor or homeowner performing this work must have adequate insurance to cover any damage to Township/Sewer Authority owned property. The amount of insurance will be determined at a date prior to hook ups.

GRANTS:

The township has funds available in the form of grants and loans for low to moderate income households to pay for the cost of hooking your home to the Central Sewer System. Grant applications can be obtained from the township office, or online at www.scotttownship.org. The deadline for grant application submittal is April 1, 2011.
